The Eastern Rensselaer County Solid Waste Management Authority is pleased to bring you the 2025 Members Calendar. The goal of this publication, funded in part by the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation, is to provide citizens from all of the ERCSWMA member communities with the information and motivation that they need to fully participate in their municipal recycling programs. Please take advantage of the opportunities and information available to **REDUCE** the amount of solid waste your household generates, to **REUSE** items whenever possible, and **RECYCLE** as many items as possible.

A Brief History of Nassau

The area we now call Nassau was originally the ancestral home to native hunters and gathers called the Mohicans (or Mahicans.) While European settlement came to the Hudson River lowlands in the 1620's, it was not until the 1750's and 1760's that the area now known as Nassau was permanently settled. With the arrival of year-round residents, came mills, inns and commerce.

In 1806 the Township of Nassau was formed from parts of Petersburgh, Stephentown and Schodack. 13 years later, on March 12, 1819, the Village of Nassau was incorporated with a population of 300. In the following 200 years Nassau Village became the economic and social hub of Southern Rensselaer County. With manufacturing, educational academies and houses of worship, Nassau grew into a prosperous self-contained community.

Services provided by the ERCSWMA to Member Communities

- Preparation & implementation of approved solid waste management plan, including all reporting and all interaction with NYSDEC
- Long-term waste disposal contract with a well-run, well-insured and fully permitted waste disposal site
- Household Hazardous Waste collections days
- Electronics recycling
- Grant writing and administration
- Oversight of the ERC Community Warehouse, reuse center
- Marketing of recyclables
- Procurement and maintenance of roll offs for cleanup days and recyclables
- Transportation contract and scheduling for roll offs containing MSW, recyclables and C&D from community transfer stations to disposal sites/markets, including special needs and follow up issues
- Development and production of educational materials
- Outreach and positive publicity though local outlets
- Community clean up days for bulky items, scrap metals, tires, etc.
- Assistance with local waste/recycling collection bids and contracts
- Reduction/Reuse/Recycling events and research
- Technical assistance to residents, business or government leaders regarding waste and recycling issues

- Paper Milk/Juice Cartons (No Foil Pouches)
- Phone Books
- Prescription drug bottles (empty)
- Rigid Plastics
- Shredded Paper (must be in clear plastic bags)
